# <u>GETACTIVE! SINGAPORE</u> <u>PESTA SUKAN 2019</u> <u>CANOE POLO CHAMPIONSHIPS</u>

### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The competition shall be administered in accordance and governed by the Singapore National Games 2019 Rules and Regulations.
- 1.2. All competitions in the Pesta Sukan 2019 shall be held in accordance with these Rules and Regulations, and the International Canoe Federation ("ICF") Canoe Polo Competition Rules 2019. The SCF reserves the right to modify these Rules and Regulations without prior notice.

### 2. **Competition Venue & Schedule**

2.1. This year's competition will be held over two weekends – 27, 28 July, 3 and 4 August 2019 from 8am to 9pm at Toa Payoh Swimming Complex, located at 301 Lor 6 Toa Payoh, Singapore 319392. Two competition categories are planned – Open (Men & Women) and Inter-Tertiary Competition "ITC" (Men & Women) and the competition pool will be the playing court for both the categories. ICF Canoe Polo Competition Rules 2019 shall apply and be adhered to by players and coaches in all categories.



### 2.2. Schedule

### 3. Registration

Registration will be open on 6 June 2019 and the closing date for the registration will be 20 June.

Minimum 5 players up to a maximum of 10 players to sign up per team.

Entry fees are in accordance with the fees in the table below.

There is a limit to the age of the players registering for each categories:

\*Age based on 1 Jan of prevailing year

Closing date for entry will be **on 20 June 2019.** Registration must be completed via myactivesg.com no later than 20 June 2019 (Wed).

Steps for registration and payment are as detailed:

- a) Entry fees are strictly non-refundable.
- b) Payment of the entry fees may only be made via myactivesg.com
  - i. E-wallet
  - ii. Credit Card
- c) ActiveSG credits cannot be used for registration

A Team Managers' Meeting will be conducted on Friday, 19 July 2019 at 1930hrs at Team Nila Room. Only the Team Manager or one appointed representative from each Organisation is permitted to attend the meeting. <u>Team Managers / representatives</u> <u>must retain and bring along proof of payment at the Team Manager Meeting</u>.

### 4. Equipment

All participants shall use their own equipment for the competition.

### 5. Prize and Medals

5.1 Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) winners (teams) of each event with at least four (4) entries.

5.2. Any event with less than 4 entries will be cancelled.

### 6. Registration Eligibility

- 6.1. All participants shall be Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents (PRs) and foreigners residing in Singapore with the passes as stated in the General Rules & Regulations.
- 6.2. Each team is allowed to register up to a maximum number of 10 players. Where max 8 players will be allowed in water at every game.
- 6.3. Each team is allowed to start the game with a minimal number of 5 players in this Championships.

### 7. Bad Weather

In the event of bad weather, the organizing committee reserves the right to delay the commencement, or cancel the games on the basis of prolonged bad weather conditions, without refund.

### 8. Alternations in Entries, Withdrawals and Walkovers

- 8.1. Teams that failed to report one game before their first game shall be considered to have voluntarily walkover.
- 8.2. No alteration to the athletes will be allowed after the closing date of registration.
- 8.3. Entry fees are not refundable except where an application is refused.
- 8.4. Withdrawal of entries after the processing of entries is permitted. No entry fee will be refunded for any withdrawn entry.
- 8.5. Any team that walkover will be awarded a 3 points loss and gets a 7 goals against to their disadvantage.

### 9. Safety Measures

9.1. Every participant must wear a personal floatation device (life vest), helmet and spray deck while competing and failing to do so will be disqualified and be removed from the competition.

- 9.2. All participants' equipment must be checked and pass the scrutineering regulations before competition starts.
- 9.3. Teams must wear uniform jerseys or similar color top under their life vest during matches. No sleeveless top will be allowed.
- 9.4. The top color of the kayak has to be uniformed throughout all players in the same team. Color of helmet and kayak do not have to be the same.

### **10.** Competition Rules

All competitions shall be held in accordance with these Rules and Regulations, and the ICF Canoe Polo Competition Rules 2019 will be implemented.

### 11. Disqualification

- 11.1. Teams/ players who does not comply with ICF Canoe Polo Competition Rules 2019.
- 11.2. An athlete who attempts to win a competition by irregular means, willfully breaks the rules, or who contests their validity, as deemed by the officials, may be disqualified for the competition (DQ).

### 12. Disciplinary Actions

# The organizing committee reserves the right to decide and execute the disciplinary actions if deem necessary.


### 13. Canoe Polo Level 1 (CP 1) Certificate

All players participating in the Open categories must be CP1-certified. The CP1 certificate numbers of all players must be filled during the registration.



### 14. Open Category

### Scenario 1 (20 Guys Team, 14 Girls Team)




After round 1 of round robin, the top 2 of each group will proceed on to round 2 (quarter-finals). Each team will face a pre-allocated team according to their respective position. The winners will proceed onto round 3 (semi-finals). Winner in the semi-finals will compete for the first placing.




After round 1 of round robin, the top of each group of 4 and the top two from the group of 6 will proceed on to round 2 (semi-finals). Each team will face a pre-allocated team according to their respective position. Winner in the semi-finals will compete for the first placing.

### Scenario 2 (16 Guys Team, 10 Girls Team)



After round 1 of round robin, the top 2 teams of each group will proceed on to round 2 (quarter finals). Each team will face a pre-allocated team according to their respective position. The losing teams will proceed on to another round of round robin to determine the 5th to 8th placing, while the winning team will proceed to the semi-finals. Winner in the semi-finals will compete for the first placing.




After round 1 of round robin, the top 4 teams of each group will proceed on to round 2 (quarter finals). Each team will face a pre-allocated team according to their respective position. The losing teams will proceed on to another round of round robin to determine the 5th to 8th placing, while the winning team will proceed to the semi-finals. Winner in the semi-finals will compete for the first placing.

### 15. ITC

**Requirements for this category:** 

- 1. Matriculated student; with student card and matriculation number
- 2. Started first semester in Academic Year 2018/2019 (across all year of studying)

Scenario (6 Guys Team, 6 Girls Team)



After 1st round of round robin, we will proceed on to the 2nd round (semi-finals). The 1st team will play with the 4th team and the 2nd team will play with the 3rd team. Winner of each match will move on to compete for the first placing in the 3rd round, while the losing team will compete for the 3rd placing in 3rd round.

### 16. Competition Equipment

Do note that Size 4 Canoe Polo ball will be used for Woman event and Size 5 Canoe Polo ball will be used for Men event. Also, as detailed in the earlier section, the registration fee per team is S\$75. Participants are to arrange for own equipment. No rental of equipment is available.

### 17. Matters not covered in Rules and Regulations

For matters not covered in the rules and regulations will be decided by the organizing committee and its decision is final.

The organizing committee reserves the right to amend the Rules and Regulations without giving prior notification or any reasons thereof.
