Scrutineering

This is a reminder that Scrutineering shall be held on 26th July (6pm-9pm) at Toa Payoh Swimming Complex, conducted by Evan Kong. Those who have failed will undergo a second round on 27th July (7am-10am) before the commencement of the competition. All team players shall be present during scrutineering. It is also the responsibility of the teams and players to ensure that all equipment used in the competition are scrutinised.

Competition Details

Competition Grounds



This is a map of the competition ground. It consists of one competition court, officials' area, allocated equipment storage areas, and warm up area.

Teams and players are to take note of the designated areas and restricted areas and shall abide by rules set forth at these areas to ensure a conducive competition environment.

General rules:

- All rubbish shall be disposed at designated trash bins. All teams and players are responsible for keeping the competition ground clean.
- Players and their equipment are to be kept within the competition grounds, including thrown balls during warmup (Refer to restricted area in Annex A)

Equipment Storage Areas (in Green):

- Areas are demarcated by institution/organisation/teams. Teams and players are to place their equipment in their allocated areas.

- Teams and players may leave their equipment at competition ground during the competition weekend (i.e. from Saturday to Sunday) and between the 2 weekends (27 - 28 July and 3 - 4

August), at their own risk. The competition committee or Toa Payoh Swimming Complex shall not be held liable for any damage or loss.

- Teams and players may unload their competition equipment at competition ground the day before the competition weekends, i.e. Fridays, from 1800hrs onwards. Please note that the competition ground (swimming pool) closes at 2100hrs, and entry is strictly not allowed thereafter. Alternatively, teams and players may also unload their competition equipment at any period before their game on competition days. Team POCs are required to notify the Organizing Committee on their planned logistical arrangements, i.e. date/time via the official WhatsApp group chat.

- Teams and players shall make logistical arrangements to clear their competition equipment from competition ground on 28 July (Sun) before 2100hrs, and on 04 August (Sun) before 2100hrs.

Warm up Area (in Purple):

- Teams and players must only pass/throw ball within the designated areas, strictly no players or balls may enter the area around the diving pool (outside of the competition ground). Teams and players shall be extra mindful not to cause damage to any existing infrastructure, including lampposts or any vehicles.

- There is strictly no throwing of ball against any pillar or wall within the premises of Toa Payoh Swimming Complex

Competition court (Swimming Pool):

- This refers to the area within a one-metre boundary surrounding each of the competition court.

- Teams and players can only enter the competition court after the end of the 1st half of the preceding game and must stay within the substitution area. Teams and players are reminded to be punctual for their scheduled game, and sanctions apply for late reporting. Passing / throwing of balls are strictly not allowed within the substitution area and sanctions apply for such infringements.

- Teams and players are to leave the competition court immediately after their game. Any unnecessary delay in exiting the competition court shall be deemed as an unsportsmanlike behaviour and may render a warning (green) card from the referee. The green card will take effect in the next game.

Access Card

For this year's competition, an access card will be issued to every individual in a registered team. The access card must be shown to ActiveSG staff on duty at the front gate for free access into Toa Payoh Swimming Complex. Individuals with passes can collect light snacks at stalls on 27th & 28th July and 3rd & 4th August (subject to food availability). For players that wish to invite family and friends, a screenshot of this card would allow for them to enter the complex free. Please refrain from sharing this as Toa Payoh swimming complex still functions as a commercial facility.

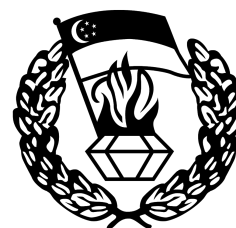
