


Venue

Note: In case of, there are less than 6 NFs participating, the championships will be cancelled.

ICF Sprint Training Camp for the Asian Region

This camp will be held before the season of competition (31 May - 16 June 2024), RCAT cooperate with ICF to have the TIP Camp (12 - 16 June 2024) especially for the Asian countries.

- To train young generation of Asian Sprint paddlers for the next Olympic cycle
- This Sprint Training camp will last a bit more than **2 weeks**, at the Rayong excellence center in Thailand, followed by Asian Canoe Sprint Junior and U23 Championships.
- NFs are requested to apply for 1 male athlete and 1 female athlete, both under 20 years old with a coach
- No fee for participating to the training camp, accommodation and food on site will be covered by ICF
- Some NFs are eligible to receive support from IOC Olympic Solidarity for their flights.
- The ICF will automatically inform IOC if they apply for the camp: Cambodia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Iraq, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam

Transportation

OC arranges the round trip from airport – official accommodation, local transportation from the venue to hotel and also turn during the event. The transportation fee is varied from the arrival and departure, one round trip, and with or without paddle.

- **Suvarnabhumi International Airport (BKK):** 40 USD/person/trip. The meeting point at Arrival floor at Exit 3-4.
- **Don Muang International Airport (DMK):** 50 USD/person/trip. The meeting point at: Arrival floor at Exit 5.
- **U Tapao International Airport (UTP):** 20 USD/person/trip. The meeting point at Arrival floor Exit 2.

The boat transportation in case of brining your own boats, the fee is 2,000 THB per one way trip.
