1. General Information

1.1 Introduction of Nanchang city



Nanchang is located in the central and northern part of Jiangxi Province, the lower reaches of Ganjiang River and Fuhe River, and the southwest bank of Poyang Lake. It is an important transportation hub connecting east, west and North, with a total area of 7,402 square kilometers and a permanent population of 6,538,100 by the end of 2022. It has jurisdiction over 6 districts and 3 counties. This national historical and cultural city was founded in 202 BC and named Nanchang in Ming Dynasty, which means "prosperity in the South" and "Changda southern Xinjiang". With more than 600 cultural sites, it is also "the place where the military flag rises" and has profound red culture.

Nanchang has the unique advantages of hosting events. Ganjiang River runs through the city, Meiling National Forest Park has beautiful mountains and waters, and beautiful natural scenery. Tengwang Pavilion, Xishan Longevity Palace and many other historical sites with profound cultural heritage; As a

modern city, urban construction is developing rapidly, citizens are enthusiastic about participating in sports, and the city is full of vitality.

1.2 Weather

The climate of Nanchang in Jiangxi province belongs to the subtropical monsoon climate, which is humid, mild and full of sunshine. Nanchang is located in the subtropical region of the northern hemisphere. Affected by the East Asian monsoon, Nanchang has a typical subtropical monsoon climate. The city is rich in heat, abundant rain and sufficient sunlight, and the rain and heat match in the growing season of crops is good, which is conducive to agricultural production.

The climatic characteristics of Nanchang include:

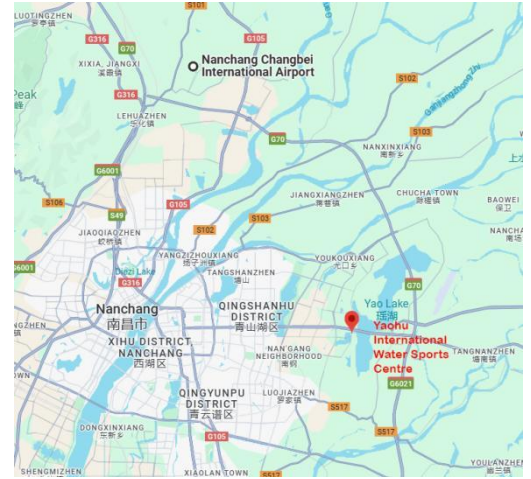
(1) Warm and humid spring: spring enters in early March, the daytime temperature is generally above 15°C, and the temperature rises further in mid-April, with the highest temperature reaching more than 25°C. The spring precipitation is more, the average monthly precipitation is about 120 mm, accompanied by more rainy weather.

(2) Summer hot and humid: summer temperature is high, the highest temperature can reach 35°C or more. Summer precipitation is more, the average monthly precipitation is about 150 mm, most of the precipitation concentrated in the Meiyu season. Summer is hot and rainy, sunny and less cloudy, often thundershowers.

1.3 Airport

Nanchang Changbei International Airport (KHN)

The airport is 40km or half an hour ride away from the venue (Yaohu International Water Sports Center).



1.4 Competition Venue

Yaohu International Water Sports Center, Nanchang City, Jiangxi Province.



The main stand of Yaohu International Water Sports Center can accommodate 800 people, and the whole arena can accommodate about 8,000 people. It can undertake the highest level of international and national water sports competitions, and can undertake the training of national team and provincial teams. It is the national water sports training base and the living and training base of water sports athletes in Jiangxi province. The venue integrates competition, training life and mass entertainment. It is a classic work of Nanchang Water article, and a pearl on the water and a bright name card of Nanchang East Gate.

It has successfully held the Asian Rowing Junior Championships, attracting many Asian young rowers to compete in this venue, showing the youth style; It has also successfully hosted the National City Games, bringing together athletes from all over the country to launch a fierce sports competition. In addition, the National Canoe Sprint Championships and the Canoe Sprint competition of National Youth Games were also held here, bringing the speed and passion of canoeing events to the audience again and again, and promoting the vigorous development of related sports.

2.5 Uniform

All participants must wear the official uniform of their own national team.

2.6 Entries

The championships are open to all members of the Asian Canoe Federation.

Each National Federation is allowed to enter only ONE (1) ENTRY per event.

* Participants are requested to provide information about all participants in the Accreditation form, including the coach and accompanying staff, as well as a copy of their passport and one photograph as passport size.

2.7 Participation Fee

All participants (except technical officials, referees, and President and Secretary General of each National Federation) will pay participation fee of USD 30 per person per day, which includes the following:

- Airport transfer to and from official hotel and the airport (Nanchang Changbei International Airport);
- Registration and ID cards for participants and team staff;
- Access to competition venues for training and other activities;
- Boat storage;
- Free Wi-Fi at the competition venues;
- Drinking water during the competition;
- Security services;
- First aids and other medical services.

* Participation fees apply for the period between May 5th and May 10th. If you arrive early or leave late, please contact the organizing committee.

* Each team is required to complete the Arrival and Departure Form and send it to the Organizing Committee by email (yjs_2025@hotmail.com) before April 20, 2025.

Jinling Hotel





Jinling Hotel is close to Aixi Lake Wetland Park, the premier Deep Oxygen Forest Wetland National park in Nanchang. Guests can have a panoramic view of Aixi Lake from the window. It is 7km or 15min ride from the competition venue, 36km from KHN Airport.

Tangning Wyndham Garden Hotel





Tangning Wyndham Garden Hotel is located at No. 398, 2nd Aixi Lake Road, East bank of Aixi Lake, High-tech Zone, Nanchang City. It is 5km or 10min ride from the competition venue, 36km from KHN Airport.

Yaohu Mingzhu Hotel



Yaohu Mingzhu Hotel is located on Tianxiang Avenue. It is 4km or 8min ride from the competition venue, 33km from KHN Airport.
