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1. About The Selection Policy

This is the selection policy for the following Age-Group (Junior, U21, and U23) International Competitions:

1. 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup (Rotorua, New Zealand, 1-3 May 2026)
2. 2026 ACC Asian Junior & U23 Championships (Turkestan, Kazakhstan, 4-7 June 2026)
3. 2026 ICF World Junior & U23 Championships (Halifax, Canada, 1-5 July 2026)
4. 2026 Olympic Hopes Regatta (Bratislava, Slovakia, 17-20 September 2026)
5. 2026 ICF Canoe Marathon World Championships (U23 and Junior Categories) (Guauguaychú, Argentina, 22-25 Oct 2026)
6. 2026 ACC Canoe Marathon Asian Cup (Age Group Categories) (Jiangle, China, 25-29 Nov 2026)

Any competitions currently not listed in this policy may be added as an addendum.

3. Eligibility

Athletes who wish to qualify for the Age-Group International Competitions (Junior, U21, U23) must meet all of the following criteria:

- Singapore Citizen if aged 21 years old and above
- Meet selection criteria as per the Age-Group International Competitions (Junior, U21, U23) Selection Policy
- Must be in good financial standing with SCF and have no outstanding dues
- Must be in good standing and have not brought SCF into disrepute
- If not already an existing National Athlete, agree to comply with the provisions of the SCF National Athlete Handbook (Canoe/Kayak Sprint), including SCF's funding policy for international competition.
- Agree to adhere to team commitments, including participation in team activities where their presence or images contribute towards giving back to the sport and the wider community

Junior – Born on 1 Jan 2008 or later

U21 – Born on 1 Jan 2005 or later

U23 – Born on 1 Jan 2003 or later

4. Selection Criteria

- 4.1 Athletes may earn a quota through the designated Selection Competitions.
- a. For selections that consider results across more than one race e.g. Top 3 boats based on timings from the SJCC U18 and U17 K1 1000m Final A, and there is uncertainty over the actual timings due to technical issues, a race-off will take place between the affected boats directly contesting for the quotas e.g. Top 3 U18 and Top 3 U17 boats to race off.
 - b. All boats must meet the minimum Performance Criteria (Annex I).
- 4.2 If a K1 or C1 quota becomes available due to reasons including withdrawal of a selected athlete up to and including the SCF Confirmation Deadline, the quota shall be offered in the following order of priority:
- i) the next best-ranked athlete who has met the selection criteria; or
 - ii) an athlete who has already qualified in another event; or
 - iii) Notwithstanding the above, for development purposes, SCF may exercise its discretion to invite the next best-ranked athlete who has not met the selection criteria.
- 4.3 If a team boat quota becomes available due to reasons including withdrawal of a selected athlete/boat up to and including the SCF Confirmation Deadline, the quota shall be offered in the following order of priority. For avoidance of doubt, a team boat quota becomes available when any member withdraws.
- i) the next best-ranked team boat who has met the selection criteria; or
 - ii) a team boat who has already qualified in another event.
 - iii) Notwithstanding the above, for development purposes, SCF may exercise its discretion to invite the next best-ranked team boat who has not met the selection criteria.
- 4.4 After the team has been confirmed for a competition, any quota place that becomes available (e.g. K1 quota, one seat in a K2) may be offered to an athlete from the selected team as an additional event. This is a coaching decision as determined by the National Coaches and approved by the High Performance Management Committee. The decision is final and not subject to appeal.
- 4.5 For competitions with more than one quota available per event, the quotas shall be awarded to unique individuals/boats.
- i) If an athlete/boat has already secured a quota in the same event through another designated Selection Competition, the quota shall be offered to the next best-ranked eligible athlete/boat from the respective Selection Competition.
 - ii) If a quota becomes available due to reasons including withdrawal of a selected athlete/boat up to and including the SCF Confirmation Deadline, the quota shall be offered to the next best-ranked eligible athlete/boat from the respective Selection Competition through which the quota was earned.
 - iii) For avoidance of doubt, where quotas are earned through different Selection Competitions, any reallocated quota shall remain tied to the respective Selection Competition from which the quota originated.

Should there be interest from more than one boat to contest a particular event, a race off will be held during the 2026 Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup (23 & 24 May).

Men & Women Canoe U23

The top U23 athlete from the C1 500m for Canoe Men and top U23 athlete from the C1 200m for Canoe Women are selected from the 2026 Singapore Canoe Sprint Championships (28 & 29 Mar).

Women Canoe U18 and Mixed Canoe U18

As there are currently no competitive Junior U18 Women Canoe athletes in Singapore, SCF will not field athletes in these events.

All other events

Crews/relay teams and individual events not specified will be formed based on athletes already qualified from the above events, by Coaches' Decision and not the Selection Committee. Decision is final and not subject to appeal.

The top U23 athlete from the C1 500m for Canoe Men and top U23 athlete from the C1 200m for Canoe Women are selected from the 2026 Singapore Canoe Sprint Championships (28 & 29 Mar).

Examples (Applying Section 4.5)

i) Athlete A wins both the SJCC U17 MK1 500m and the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MK1 500m events. Quota 1 shall be awarded to Athlete A, while Quota 2 shall be awarded to Athlete B, who placed second in the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MK1 500m event. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.)

ii) Athlete A wins both the SJCC U17 MK1 500m and the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MK1 500m events, while Athlete B places second in both competitions. Athlete A subsequently withdraws from OHR. The SJCC quota shall then be reallocated to Athlete B as the next best-ranked eligible athlete from SJCC. The Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup quota shall be awarded to Athlete C, who placed third in the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MK1 500m event. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.)

Women Kayak

U17 K1 500m	The first quota goes to the winner from the SJCC U17 K1 500m Final A. The second quota goes to the Top U17 K1 from the 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U18 K1 500m Final.
U16 K1 500m	The first quota goes to the winner from the SJCC U16 K1 500m Final A. The second quota goes to the Top U16 K1 from the 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U16 K1 500m Final or Semi Final.
U15 K1 500m	The first quota goes to the winner from the SJCC U15 K1 500m Final A. The second quota goes to the Top U15 K1 from the 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U16 K1 500m Final or Semi Final.

Examples (Applying Section 4.5)

i) Athlete A wins the SJCC U17 WK1 500m event and is also the top U17 WK1 500m boat in the 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U18 WK1 500m Final. Quota 1 shall be awarded to Athlete A, while Quota 2 shall be awarded to Athlete B, who is the next best-ranked eligible U17 boat in the Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U18 WK1 500m Final. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.) If there is no other eligible U17 athlete in the Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U18 WK1 500m Final, the quota shall be awarded to the next best-ranked eligible U17 WK1 500m athlete from the Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U18 WK1 500m event overall.

ii) Athlete A wins both the SJCC U16 WK1 500m event and is the top U16 WK1 500m boat in the 2026 Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U16 WK1 500m Final, while Athlete B places second in both competitions. Athlete A subsequently withdraws from OHR. The SJCC quota shall then be reallocated to Athlete B as the next best-ranked eligible athlete from SJCC. The Asia Pacific Sprint Cup quota shall be awarded to Athlete C, who is the next best-ranked eligible U16 WK1 500m athlete in the Asia Pacific Sprint Cup U16 WK1 500m event. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.)

i) Athlete A wins both the SJCC U17 MC1 500m and the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MC1 500m events. Quota 1 shall be awarded to Athlete A, while Quota 2 shall be awarded to Athlete B, who placed second in the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MC1 500m event. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.)

ii) Athlete A wins both the SJCC U17 MC1 500m and the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MC1 500m events, while Athlete B places second in both competitions. Athlete A subsequently withdraws from OHR. The SJCC quota shall then be reallocated to Athlete B as the next best-ranked eligible athlete from SJCC. The Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup quota shall be awarded to Athlete C, who

placed third in the Singapore Canoe Sprint Cup U17 MC1 500m event. (Assuming both athletes meet the eligibility criteria.)

Women Canoe

As there are currently no competitive U17 Women Canoe athletes in Singapore, SCF will not field athletes in these events.

All other events

Crews/relay teams and individual events not specified will be formed based on athletes already qualified from the above events, by Coaches' Decision and not the Selection Committee. Decision is final and not subject to appeal.

5.5 2026 ICF Canoe Marathon World Championships (U23 and Junior Categories) (Guauguaychú, Argentina, 22-25 Oct 2026)

The competition comprises **15 events for U23 and Juniors**. All events listed below are Junior categories unless otherwise stated.

Selections take place at the Selection Trials on 15 Aug (C1/K1) and 16 Aug (C2/K2), in the format of 3 loops of 3.3km including a portage every loop.

For avoidance of doubt, U23 athletes are automatically considered for both the Senior and U23 selections.

Long distance events

Subject to meeting the timing criteria, top 2 boats are selected for the long distance events.

Short distance events

Athletes will be selected from those already qualified for the long distance events. To manage the competition load, the order of priority is:

1. Athlete who has qualified for either the C1/K1 or C2/K2 long distance event, ranked by C1/K1 timings at the Selection Trials on 15 Aug (C1/K1).
2. Athlete who has qualified for both the C1/K1 and C2/K2 long distance event, ranked by C1/K1 timings at the Selection Trials on 15 Aug (C1/K1).

- b. Appeals must be sent with supporting documentation to SCF's High Performance Manager (HPM) hpm@scf.org.sg within 48 hours of the announcement of the selection results. The appeal must be accompanied by a deposit of S\$100.00, payable to SCF. If the appeal is successful, the deposit will be refunded in full.
- c. The Appeals Committee may request additional information from the athlete through SCF's HPM if necessary, to further deliberate on the merits of the appeal.
- d. The outcome of the appeal will be conveyed to the athlete within 21 days.
